## **Shiloh London Named Interim Executive Director of the Network of California Community College Foundations**

**SACRAMENTO**— Shiloh London, currently the Director of Development Operations for the Foundation for California Community Colleges (FCCC), has been named the Interim Executive Director of the Network of California Community College Foundations (NCCCF), effective immediately. She will carry out both roles until a permanent Executive Director is named later this year.

London's selection comes after an extensive search, including the screening of more than 60 candidates by a four-person search committee. London, who was not among the initial candidates, was selected due to her similar roles and responsibilities at the FCCC, and her extensive background in marketing and fund-raising.

“Finding the ideal candidate is imperative for this exciting time of growth for our network,” said Ginger Ontiveros, Board President of the NCCCF. “We are pleased to have such a qualified and enthusiastic interim executive director in Shiloh London to help us move forward seamlessly.”

London joined the FCCC in early March to help launch its fund-raising efforts by providing vital operational support in developing a campaign strategy, creating and maintaining relationships with donors and sponsors, coordinating special events, and other development-related activities. Her prior experience includes more than 10 years in community development, campaign management and public relations roles.

“In her short time with the Foundation, Shiloh has done an excellent job in helping launch our unprecedented efforts to raise philanthropic dollars for California Community Colleges,” said Foundation President and CEO Paul Lanning. “Since the nature of her work as Interim Executive Director for the NCCCF will not greatly differ from her current responsibilities or past experiences, Shiloh makes an ideal candidate to help both organizations reach their goals until a permanent solution is identified.”

London is expected to serve as Interim Executive Director until the NCCCF's 2008 Symposium, which is slated for October 15 to 17 in San Diego. At that time, the NCCCF board will reevaluate the position and determine next steps.
